

2018-2019 TEC VP REPORT

This update ranges from my last report submitted for the 2018 Philadelphia ANA/TEC meeting, until the day this report was completed on 7/27/2019. Since my last report I've been producing the clubs issued coins and getting ready for the Chicago show. Also, in addition to the VP position, I've continued as the admin of the TEC Facebook page.

I'm happy to report that the TEC Facebook page we've had a few great changes, we've added our newest governor Bob Frazier as a moderator to assist in the day to day monitoring of the page content. Between myself, Uni Marbutt (Moderator) and now Bob Frazier (Moderator) the Facebook page has been a success, it is a team effort. As of July 17th, the number of Facebook 'members' is 674. It is important to note that we do not require actual TEC membership to participate in the TEC Facebook page. It is our hope that its existence and our persistence will bring new members to the club.

- 10) Join TEC Rolled on nickels (future issue).

For Reimbursement (see attachment) I had \$1,142.99 in expenses. Rolling in excess of 12,873 elongateds for the club, with another 2,400 slated to roll in the next few weeks.

I look forward to continuing as the admin of The Elongated Collectors Face Book Group, and Vice President of our great club. It's my belief that 2020 will be even better than 2019, we will be way ahead on the rolling of coins and perhaps you will add a few great coins to your collection! Happy collecting.
