The 2020 Elongated Coin Design Contest theme was "A Day at the Zoo". The contest was announced in the January TEC News and entries were due at the end of February. Reminders were sent out via the TEC Facebook Page. This year we had a grand total of thirty-one designs received. Twenty-six designs were from twelve regular members and five designs were from five different junior members. This year's winning design was submitted by Mindy McCracken (TEC #4883) and the winning design for the Junior member was submitted by Salvidor Cade (TEC #5209). All TEC members received elongated coins with the winning designs with the July TEC News. Additionally, the winners received a complete denomination set (Penny, Nickel, Dime and Quarter) and 25 additional pennies of their designs. All of the entries can be seen on the TEC News website.
