



2020-2021 TEC VP REPORT

This update ranges from my last report submitted for the canceled 2020 Chicago ANA/TEC meeting, until the day this report was completed on 6/15/2021. Since my last report I've been producing the clubs issued coins and getting ready for the Chicago show. Also, in addition to the VP position, I've continued as the admin of the TEC Facebook page.

I'm happy to report that the TEC Facebook page is booming. We had an issue with a crypto currency being named Elongate and thus a tsunami of crypto currency followers applying to join. To curb the number of applicants that were not interested in 'The Elongated Collectors' I moved Bob Frazier to assist in the Admin duties. Bob created a list of questions that helps weed out the applicants. Uni Marbutt also plays a large roll in moderating the group. Our current number in the Facebook group is over 1,145 strong.
